Sing

Think

As a class, brainstorm all the different ways you can save water in your house each day; for example, put a bucket in the shower and use the water to water your garden.

Many places in Australia are currently on water restrictions. Discuss what this means, why it is necessary, how the environment plays a role in water supply and how we can save water. Write or draw as many ways as you can to help us save water.
