



WHAT IS ROADZONE?

NRMA RoadZone is a FREE, hands-on exhibition about the science of road safety for students aged 9 -14 years.

NRMA RoadZone tours NSW and the ACT. Most of it's exhibits use interactive multimedia technology to simulate how you can stay safe on the road. Visitors can experience how their behaviour on the road affects their safety, whether they're a pedestrian, cyclist, skateboarder, passenger or driver. The exhibit's key messages range from judging the speed of cars, peer pressure, through to car braking distances and hazard spotting.

You can preview the Exhibition by taking a virtual tour plus test drive two exhibits - Stopping Distances and The 3 Second Rule.

ROAD SAFETY SCIENCE SHOW

A part of NRMA RoadZone is a Road Safety Science Show. The Show is a multimedia and science demonstration show suitable for students aged 9-14 years. The show may be performed at the exhibition venue, or RoadZone staff may come to your school to perform a FREE 40 minute multimedia show about road safety.

In the first 6 months of 2006 NRMA RoadZone will be in Taree, Bathurst and Wollongong.

RuleSmartz 4 Kidz is a new interactive road safety game developed by NRMA Motoring & Services for children aged 7 to 11.

The main aim of the game is to teach and reinforce, vital road safety messages in a learning format which is fun and entertaining.

RuleSmartz 4 Kidz has two sections a game and a quiz. In the Game section children are able to select a character that can either walk or cycle and as the player proceeds through scenarios they are tested on their ability to make safe choices, for example getting off their bike to cross the road. The Quiz section is multiple choice which tests player's knowledge on road safety.

The game is proving popular with children as they keep playing until they get a perfect score.

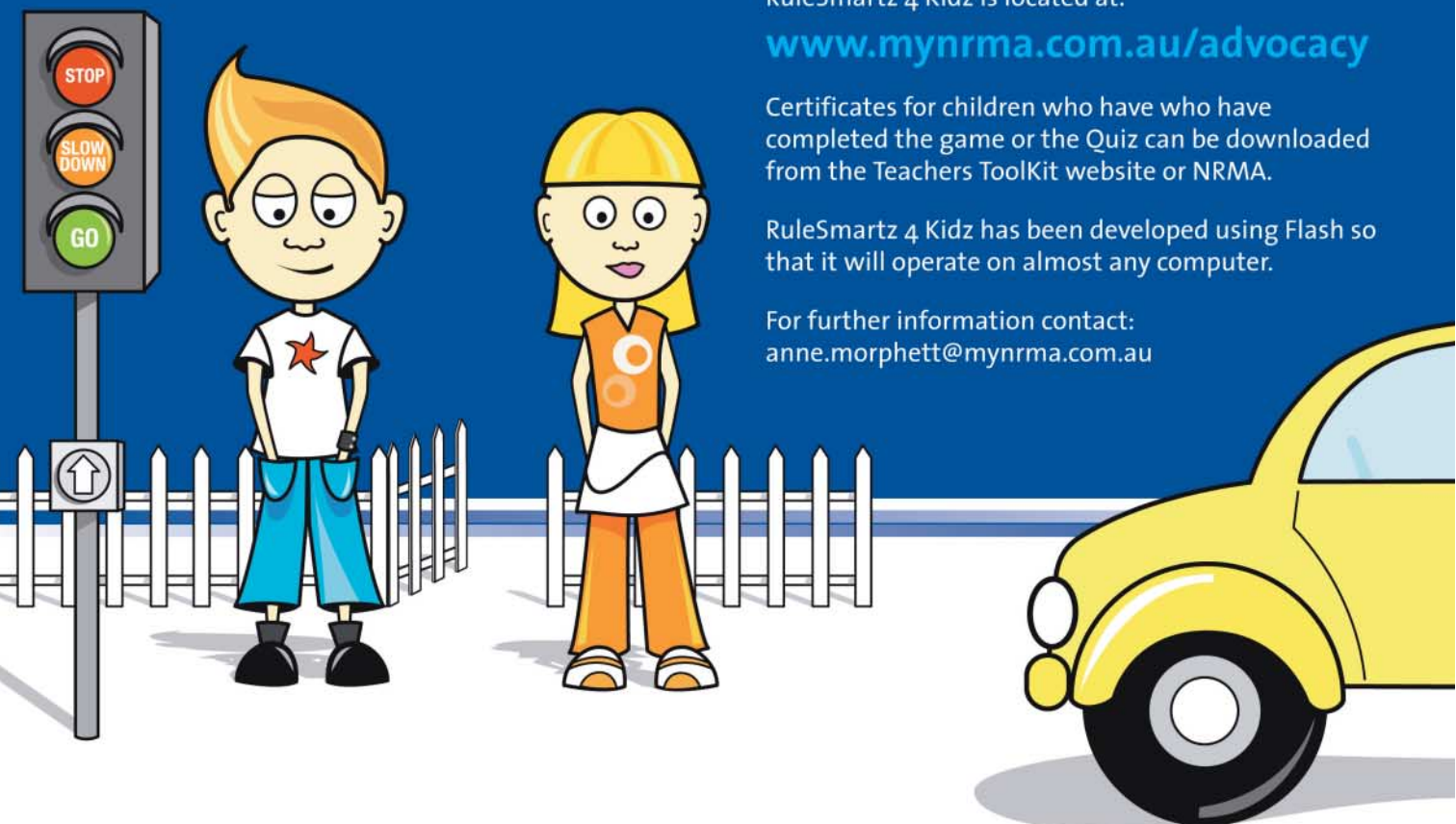
