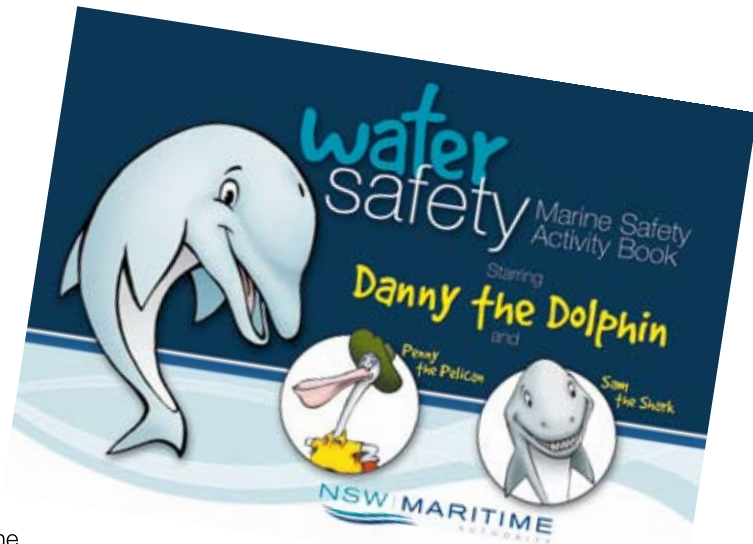


Water Safety: Marine Safety Activity Book

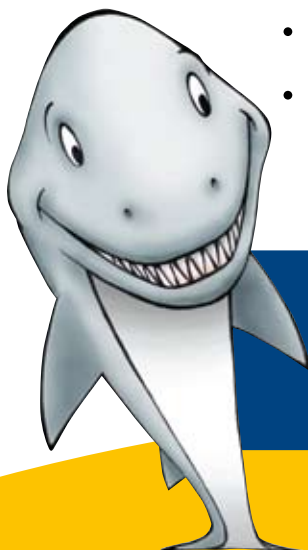
- recognition of important safety, fishing and water-related signs
